A. Introduction – This is where we find common ground.

B. Transition statement – This is where we place a feeler out regarding their relationship with God.

Eg. (“So are you a church goer?”)

C. Assessment – I generally ask permission to ask the person 2 personal questions:

1. If you were to die today, are you certain you would go to Heaven?
2. If Jesus were to be sitting right here and asked you, ‘Why should I let you into my Heaven’, what would you say?

D. Response – this will be determined by their response:

1. They tell you it just doesn’t matter.

Hebrews 9:27 (ESV) - “...it is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment...”

2. They tell you they are a good person.

Eph 2:8-9 “^sFor it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—^anot by works, so that no one can boast.”

Isaiah 64:6 (NIV) “^aAll of us have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous acts are like filthy rags...”

3. They tell you they have already accepted Christ in their lives. “That is awesome, well then let me pray for you that God will continue to strengthen your faith”

E. Personal Story – Life before, How I met Christ, and Life with Christ.

F. Support with Scripture –

G. Seal the Deal – Ask them: “Don’t you want to know for certain if you were to die today that you would spend eternity with Christ?”

H. Lead them in a Sinners Prayer

I. Get their name and number and follow up.

Romans 3:10 - “There is no one righteous, not even one...”

Romans 3:23 - “...for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”

Romans 6:23 - “For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord:

Romans 5:8 - “But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”

Romans 10:9 - “... if you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.”

Romans 10:13 - “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

Romans 5:1 - “Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ...”

Romans 8:1 - “Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus...”

Romans 8:38-39 - “For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

Sample Prayer: “Dear Lord I realize I am a sinner and need a savior. Forgive me of my sins and come into my life as my Lord and Savior. In Jesus name I pray, Amen!”
